

## **Fine Fiber Show Information and Rules**

### **Entry Information**

Fees: \$4 for each wool fleece entered.

All entry forms must be postmarked no later than Monday, October 1, 2018.

Mail entry form and check payable to Lambtown Festival to:

Do not send fleeces to P.O Box.

Fleece arrival: Fleeces will be received at the Wool Show

- Friday, October 5 from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Saturday, October 6 from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. by prearrangement only. Contact Diane at fiberevents@lambtown.org to prearrange for Saturday morning drop off.

Shipped fleeces should be sent to Barbara Fiorica, 13059 Cherry Rd., Wilton, CA 95693 scheduled to arrive between September 26 and October 3, 2018.

Fleeces for sale: Indicate "For Sale" or "Not for Sale" and the price/pound on the entry form.

Fleeces will be weighed at check-in.

A fleece determined by the judge to have a wool break will be marked "Not for Sale."

Exhibitors will receive a check via mail for their fleece sales (less a 10% handling fee) within 15 days of the Lambtown Festival.

**Judging and Sale:** The Fine Fiber Show judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, October 6, 2018.

The Fine Fiber Sale will begin shortly after the judging is completed.

Fleece owners may add promotional materials to the bags after judging is complete.

Sold fleeces may be removed at time of sale.

All other fleeces will remain on display through 4:00 p.m. Sunday, October 7, 2018.

## Fleeces will be judged on the following points:

- 1. Fleece characteristics as outlined by breed associations
- 2. Fleeces will be examined for strength, length, handle and cleanliness, as well as overall uniformity of fleece
- 3. Total fleece weight
- 4. In all classes in these divisions the overall uniformity of fiber diameter as well as the appropriate staple length within grade will be considered

**Fleece pick-up:** Fleeces not sold need to be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 7, 2018. Exhibitors must sign a release form when removing fleeces. If you are not available to pick up your fleece, please provide a pre-paid shipping label. Fleeces that are not picked up in person and do not have a shipping label will become the property of the Lambtown Festival and sold to support the Fine Fiber Show.

### Sponsorship:

Any person or group who would like to support the Wool Show may donate \$50 to sponsor a class. Sponsors will be recognized by signage at the Wool Show and a link on the Lambtown Festival website. Sponsors may

indicate preferred class, but the Fine Fiber Show Chair will choose an alternate class if the preferred class is already spoken for.

To sponsor a class, send a \$50 check payable to *Lambtown Festival*, note "Wool Show Donation" on the check. Send check to: Fine Fiber Show Chair, P.O. Box 995, Dixon, CA 95620.

#### Rules

- 1. Fleeces should not be more than 12 months growth.
- 2. Fleeces entered must be from the current year's clip.
- 3. All fleeces should be of hand-spinner quality.
- 4. Fleeces should be skirted with tags and bellies removed.
- 5. Fleeces not in compliance will be disqualified.
- 6. Fleeces may be moved to a different class if the judge deems this necessary.
- 7. Fleeces must be submitted in clear plastic bags and displayed appropriately for the breed/fiber.
  - A "Show Cut" is not required as judging will be done from a hand-spinning fiber arts perspective.
  - Tag fleeces with the Fine Fiber Bag Tag
- 8. No more than 3 fleeces from one exhibitor in each class.

#### **Awards**

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 5th place.

Prizes will be awarded for:

- Alpaca, Huacaya Champion and Reserve Champion
- Alpaca, Suri Champion and Reserve Champion
- Cashmere, Champion and Reserve Champion
- Mohair, Champion and Reserve Champion

Premiums will be awarded depending on sponsorships. Champion Rosettes will be awarded at the judge's discretion and dependent upon the number of qualified entries.
